2	relating to the issuance of disabled veteran license plates.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 502.254(a), Transportation Code, is
5	amended to read as follows:
6	(a) The department shall issue special license plates for
7	motor vehicles with a manufacturer's rated carrying capacity of two
8	tons or less that are owned by veterans of the United States armed
9	forces. A veteran is entitled to register, for the person's own
10	use, two motor vehicles under this section if the person:
11	(1) has suffered, as a result of military service:
12	(A) at least a <u>50</u> [60] percent service-connected
13	disability; or
14	(B) a 40 percent service-connected disability
15	because of the amputation of a lower extremity; and
16	(2) receives compensation from the United States
17	because of the disability.
18	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
