- 2 relating to regulation of the use of laser pointers; providing a criminal penalty.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 42, Penal Code, is amended by adding 6 Section 42.13 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 42.13. USE OF LASER POINTERS. (a) A person commits an
- 8 offense if the person knowingly directs a light from a laser pointer
- 9 at a uniformed safety officer, including a peace officer, security
- 10 guard, firefighter, emergency medical service worker, or other
- 11 uniformed municipal, state, or federal officer.
- 12 (b) In this section, "laser pointer" means a device that
- 13 emits a visible light amplified by the stimulated emission of
- 14 radiation.

- 15 (c) An offense under this section is a Class C misdemeanor.
- 16 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
