## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to certain pharmaceutical services for an injured employee

- 3 receiving workers' compensation medical benefits.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 408.028, Labor Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:
- 7 (e) Notwithstanding Subsection (b), the commission by rule
- 8 shall allow an employee to purchase a brand name drug rather than a
- 9 generic pharmaceutical medication or over-the-counter alternative
- 10 to a prescription medication if the prescribing doctor prescribes
- 11 <u>for the employee a brand name drug or a gener</u>ic pharmaceutical
- 12 medication that may be substituted for the brand name drug. The
- employee shall be responsible for paying the difference between the
- 14 cost of the brand name drug and the cost of a comparable generic
- 15 pharmaceutical medication or comparable over-the-counter
- 16 alternative to a prescription medication.
- 17 SECTION 2. (a) This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
- 18 (b) The Texas Workers' Compensation Commission shall adopt
- 19 rules under Section 408.028(e), Labor Code, as added by this Act,
- 20 not later than March 1, 2004.
