A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the membership of the board of directors of the Texas
3 Underground Facility Notification Corporation.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 251.055(a), Utilities Code, is amended
6 to read as follows:

7 (a) The board of directors of the corporation is composed of
8 the following 13 [~~12~~] members appointed by the governor:

9 (1) six representatives of the general public;

10 (2) one representative of the gas industry;

11 (3) one representative of the telecommunications
12 industry;

13 (4) one representative of the electric industry;

14 (5) one representative of cable television companies;

15 (6) one representative of municipalities; [~~and~~]

16 (7) one representative of persons who engage in
17 excavation operations who are not also facility operators; and

18 (8) one representative of the Railroad Commission of
19 Texas.

20 SECTION 2. Section 251.056(a), Utilities Code, is amended
21 to read as follows:

22 (a) Directors serve staggered three-year terms, with the
23 terms of four or five directors expiring each August 31.

24 SECTION 3. As soon as possible after the effective date of

1 this Act, the governor shall appoint a representative of the
2 Railroad Commission of Texas to the Texas Underground Facility
3 Notification Corporation for a term expiring August 31, 2006.

4 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
