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1 terms of four <u>or five</u> directors expiring each August 31.

2 SECTION 3. As soon as possible after the effective date of 3 this Act, the governor shall appoint:

4 (1) a representative of the Public Utility Commission 5 of Texas to the Texas Underground Facility Notification Corporation 6 for a term expiring August 31, 2006; and

7 (2) a representative of the Railroad Commission of
8 Texas to the Texas Underground Facility Notification Corporation
9 for a term expiring August 31, 2005.

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SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
