- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 49, Water Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Section 49.072 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 49.072. LIMITATION ON FUTURE EMPLOYMENT. (a) A person
- 8 who has served as a director of a district may not contract with
- 9 that district or be employed by an organization to which the
- 10 district has awarded a contract for one year following the date on
- 11 which the person ceased to serve as a director.
- 12 (b) This section does not apply to a person who has served as
- 13 <u>a director of a district that performs agricultural irrigation</u>
- 14 functions under Chapter 51, 55, or 58 if the person, when serving as
- a director, was required to own land as a qualification for office.
- 16 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 17 to a person who ceases to serve as a director of a district, as
- defined by Section 49.001, Water Code, on or after the effective
- 19 date of this Act. A person who ceased to serve as a director of a
- 20 district, as defined by Section 49.001, Water Code, before the
- 21 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect at that
- time, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
