## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the public education grant program.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Subchapter G, Chapter 29, Education Code, is
- 5 amended by adding Section 29.2011 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 29.2011. DEFINITION. In this subchapter, "parent"
- 7 <u>includes a guardian or custodian.</u>
- 8 SECTION 2. Section 29.203(d), Education Code, is amended to
- 9 read as follows:
- 10 (d) A school district chosen by a student's parent under
- 11 Section 29.201 is entitled to [accept or] reject the application
- 12 for the student to attend school in that district only if 95 percent
- or more of the available positions for the grade level for which the
- 14 student is applying are filled. The district [but] may not use
- 15 criteria that discriminate on the basis of a student's race,
- 16 ethnicity, academic achievement, athletic abilities, language
- 17 proficiency, sex, or socioeconomic status. A school district that
- 18 has more acceptable applicants for attendance under this subchapter
- 19 than available positions must give priority to students at risk of
- 20 dropping out of school as defined by Section 29.081 and must fill
- 21 the available positions by lottery. However, to achieve continuity
- 22 in education, a school district may give preference over at-risk
- 23 students to enrolled students and to the siblings of enrolled
- 24 students residing in the same household or other children residing

- 1 in the same household as enrolled students for the convenience of
- 2 parents[, guardians, or custodians] of those children.
- 3 SECTION 3. Section 29.204(b), Education Code, is amended to
- 4 read as follows:
- 5 (b) Not later than February 1 of each year, a school
- 6 district shall notify in writing the parent of each student in the
- 7 district assigned to attend a campus described by Section 29.202
- 8 that the student is eligible for a public education grant. Not
- 9 later than May 1 of each year, a district shall notify in writing
- 10 the parent of each student who is registered for the following
- 11 school year to attend kindergarten at a district campus described
- 12 by Section 29.202 that the student is eligible for a public
- 13 education grant. The notice under this subsection must contain a
- 14 clear, concise explanation of the public education grant program
- and of the manner in which the parent may obtain further information
- 16 about the program.
- SECTION 4. Sections 29.203(c) and 42.4101, Education Code,
- 18 are repealed.
- 19 SECTION 5. This Act applies beginning with the 2003-2004
- 20 school year.
- 21 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 25 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
