## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

L	AN ACT

- 2 relating to the use of public school educators' days of service for
- 3 which instruction is not required.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 11.253(e), Education Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (e) In accordance with the administrative procedures
- 8 established under Section 11.251(b), the campus-level committee
- 9 shall be involved in decisions in the areas of planning, budgeting,
- 10 curriculum, staffing patterns, staff development, and school
- organization. The campus-level committee must approve:
- 12 <u>(1)</u> the portions of the campus plan addressing campus
- 13 staff development needs; and
- 14 (2) the use of educators' days of service for which
- instruction is not required, if the campus is rated exemplary under
- 16 Chapter 39.
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2003-2004
- 18 school year.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
