BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 773.046, Health and Safety Code, is 1-12 amended to read as follows:

EMERGENCY CARE ATTENDANT QUALIFICATIONS. (a) Sec. 773.046. An individual qualifies as an emergency care attendant if  $\overline{the}$  individual is certified by the department as minimally proficient to provide emergency prehospital care by providing initial aid that promotes comfort and avoids aggravation of an injury or illness.

1-18 (b) The department may not require an individual to have a high school diploma or a high school equivalency certificate for certification as an emergency care attendant under this chapter if the individual certifies that the individual will serve only as an 1-19 1-20 1-21 1-22 emergency care attendant volunteer during the certification 1-23 period. 1-24

<u>(</u>c) The board shall adopt rules as necessary to administer this section.

1-26 SECTION 2. The Texas Board of Health shall adopt the rules 1-27 necessary under Section 773.046, Health and Safety Code, as amended 1-28

by this Act, not later than January 1, 2004. SECTION 3.
