- 7 Sec. 106.002. ATTORNEY'S FEES AND EXPENSES. (a) In a suit
- 8 under this title, the court may <u>render judgment for</u> [order]
- 9 reasonable attorney's fees and expenses [as costs] and order the
- 10 judgment and postjudgment interest [fees] to be paid directly to an
- 11 attorney.
- 12 (b) <u>A judgment for [An award of]</u> attorney's fees <u>and</u>
- 13 <u>expenses</u> may be enforced in the attorney's name by any means
- 14 available for the enforcement of a judgment for debt.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003, and
- 16 applies to a suit affecting the parent-child relationship pending
- in a trial court on that date or filed on or after that date.
