- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 42.29(a), Tax Code, is amended to read as
- 6 follows:
- 7 (a) A property owner who prevails in an appeal to the court
- 8 under Section 42.25 or 42.26 may be awarded reasonable attorney's
- 9 fees. The amount of the award may not exceed the greater of:
- 10 (1) \$15,000; or
- 11 (2) an amount, not to exceed \$100,000, equal to 20
- 12 percent of the total amount by which the property owner's tax
- 13 liability is reduced as a result of the appeal.
- 14 SECTION 2. Section 42.29(b), Tax Code, is repealed.
- 15 SECTION 3. (a) This Act takes effect immediately if it
- 16 receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each
- 17 house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution.
- 18 If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate
- 19 effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
- 20 (b) The change in law made by this Act applies only to an
- 21 appeal filed under Chapter 42, Tax Code, on or after the effective
- 22 date of this Act. An appeal filed before the effective date of this
- 23 Act is governed by the law as it existed immediately before the
- 24 effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for
