- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 502, Transportation Code,
- 6 is amended by adding Section 502.3031 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 502.3031. MARINE MAMMAL RECOVERY LICENSE PLATES. (a)
- 8 The department shall issue specially designed license plates for
- 9 passenger cars and light trucks to support the activities of the
- 10 Texas Marine Mammal Stranding Network.
- 11 (b) The license plates must bear one or more graphic images
- designed by the Parks and Wildlife Department in consultation with
- 13 the Texas Marine Mammal Stranding Network.
- 14 (c) The department shall issue license plates under this
- 15 section to a person who:
- 16 (1) applies to the county assessor-collector of the
- 17 county in which the person resides on a form provided by the
- department; and
- 19 (2) pays an annual fee of \$25, in addition to the fee
- 20 prescribed by Section 502.161 or 502.162, and, if personalized
- 21 prestige license plates are issued, in addition to the fee
- 22 prescribed by Section 502.251.
- 23 (d) The fee for replacement of a lost, stolen, or mutilated
- 24 plate issued under this section is \$25, in addition to the fee

- 2 (e) Of each fee collected under this section, \$5 may be used to defray the cost of administering this section by the department 3 4 and the Parks and Wildlife Department. The department shall deposit the remainder of each fee collected under this section to 5 6 the credit of an account in the state treasury. Money in the account may be used only by the Parks and Wildlife Department to 7 8 support the activities of the Texas Marine Mammal Stranding Network in the recovery, rehabilitation, and release of stranded marine 9 mammals. The Parks and Wildlife Department shall establish 10 reporting and other mechanisms necessary to ensure that the money 11
- (f) If the owner of a vehicle registered under this section disposes of the vehicle during the registration year, the owner shall return the special license plates to the department.
- 16 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
