- 5 SECTION 1. Section 3.506(a), Business & Commerce Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) On return of a check to the holder following dishonor of
- 8 the check by a payor, the holder, the holder's assignee, agent, or
- 9 representative, or any other person retained by the holder to seek
- 10 collection of the face value of the dishonored check may charge the
- 11 drawer or endorser a reasonable processing fee of not more than \$30
- 12 [\$25].
- 13 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 14 to a check issued on or after the effective date of this Act. A
- 15 check issued before the effective date of this Act is covered by the
- 16 law in effect when the check was issued, and the former law is
- 17 continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
