4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Sections 502.2734(a), (c), and (g),
6	Transportation Code, are amended to read as follows:
7	(a) The department shall issue one or more specially
8	designed conservation license plates for the following vehicles
9	[for passenger cars and light trucks] to support Texas Parks and
10	Wildlife Department activities:

- 11 (1) passenger cars and light trucks;
- (2) trailers used primarily for the transport of 12 watercraft as defined by Section 49.01, Penal Code; 13
- (3) vehicles primarily designed as temporary living 14
- quarters for recreational camping or travel use, including travel 15
- trailers, travel semitrailers, camping trailers, camping 16
- semitrailers, and motor homes; 17
- (4) farm tractors, farm trailers, and farm 18
- semitrailers; and 19
- (5) truck-tractors, semitrailers, and commercial 20
- 21 motor vehicles.
- (c) The department shall issue license plates under this 22
- 23 section to a person who:
- 24 (1) applies to the county assessor-collector of the

- 1 county in which the person resides on an original or renewal
- 2 registration application form provided by the department; and
- 3 (2) pays an annual fee of \$25, in addition to the fee
- 4 prescribed by Section 502.161, <u>502.162</u>, <u>502.163</u>, <u>502.166</u>, <u>or</u>
- 5 502.167, and, if personalized prestige license plates are issued,
- 6 in addition to the fee prescribed by Section 502.251.
- 7 (g) There is no limit to the number of <u>vehicles</u> [<del>passenger</del>
- 8 cars or light trucks] for which a person may apply for the issuance
- 9 of license plates under this section.
- 10 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
