H.B. No. 943

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to vehicles eligible for conservation license plates
3 supporting the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Sections 502.2734(a), (c), and (g),
6 Transportation Code, are amended to read as follows:

7 (a) The department shall issue one or more specially
8 designed conservation license plates for the following vehicles
9 [~~for passenger cars and light trucks~~] to support Texas Parks and
10 Wildlife Department activities:

11 (1) passenger cars and light trucks;

12 (2) trailers used primarily for the transport of
13 watercraft as defined by Section 49.01, Penal Code;

14 (3) vehicles primarily designed as temporary living
15 quarters for recreational camping or travel use, including travel
16 trailers, travel semitrailers, camping trailers, camping
17 semitrailers, and motor homes;

18 (4) farm tractors, farm trailers, and farm
19 semitrailers; and

20 (5) truck-tractors, semitrailers, and commercial
21 motor vehicles.

22 (c) The department shall issue license plates under this
23 section to a person who:

24 (1) applies to the county assessor-collector of the

1 county in which the person resides on an original or renewal
2 registration application form provided by the department; and

3 (2) pays an annual fee of \$25, in addition to the fee
4 prescribed by Section 502.161, 502.162, 502.163, 502.166, or
5 502.167, and, if personalized prestige license plates are issued,
6 in addition to the fee prescribed by Section 502.251.

7 (g) There is no limit to the number of vehicles [~~passenger~~
8 ~~cars or light trucks~~] for which a person may apply for the issuance
9 of license plates under this section.

10 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
