13	(2) has at least five years of service credit in the

15	(3) is eligible to retire on or before August 31, 2005,

17	(b) A member described by Subsection (a) may receive service

- 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
