- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 32, Human Resources Code, is amended by 6 adding Section 32.054 to read as follows:
- 7 <u>Sec. 32.054. MEDICATIONS AND MEDICAL SUPPLIES. The</u> 8 department shall adopt rules establishing procedures for:
- 9 <u>(1) the bulk purchasing of medically necessary,</u>
 10 <u>over-the-counter medications and medical supplies that were</u>
 11 previously being provided via prescription; and
- 12 (2) the distribution of these over-the-counter

 13 medications and medical supplies to providers based upon historic

 14 Medicaid and Children's Health Insurance Program utilization rates

 15 of the over-the-counter products purchased under this section.
- SECTION 2. WAIVER. If before implementing Section 1 of this
 Act, the Health and Human Services Commission determines that a
 waiver or authorization from a federal agency is necessary for
 implementation, the commission shall request the waiver or
 authorization and may delay implementing this Act until the waiver
 or authorization is granted.
- 22 SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect 23 immediately.
