4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 33, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 33.904 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 33.904. GRANTS FOR AFTER-SCHOOL CHILD-CARE PROGRAMS.
8	(a) From funds appropriated for the purpose, the commissioner
9	shall make grants to school districts for use in operating one or
10	more after-school child-care programs for students enrolled in
11	kindergarten through grade eight.
12	(b) To be eligible for a grant under this section, a school
13	district must apply to the commissioner in the manner and within the
14	time prescribed by the commissioner.
15	(c) In awarding grants under this section, the commissioner
16	shall give priority to a school district that:
17	(1) is located primarily in a county:
18	(A) with a population of less than 500,000; and
19	(B) in which a majority of the enrolled public
20	school students are from low-income families; and
21	(2) proposes to use the grant to operate an
22	after-school child-care program at one or more schools in which a
23	significant number of the enrolled students are from low-income

families.
