A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the electronic filing of a personal financial statement
3	with the Texas Ethics Commission.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 572, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 572.0305 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 572.0305. ELECTRONIC FILING AUTHORIZED. (a) The
8	commission shall develop a system by which a financial statement
9	required to be filed under this subchapter may be filed by computer
10	diskette, CD-ROM, modem, or other means of electronic transfer,
11	using computer software provided by the commission or computer
12	software that meets commission specifications for a standard file
13	format.
14	(b) Computer software provided or approved by the
15	commission for use under this section must:
16	(1) use a standardized format for the entry of
17	information;
18	(2) provide for secure and encoded transmission of
19	data from the computer of a person filing the financial statement to
20	the computers used by the commission;
21	(3) be capable of being used by a person with basic
22	computing skills who uses a computer that uses a Windows operating
23	system, Macintosh operating system, or another operating system
24	that the commission determines is as popular as those systems for

- 2 (4) permit a person using a computer to prepare a
- 3 <u>financial</u> statement or to retrieve information from a financial
- 4 statement to:
- 5 (A) import information to the statement from a
- 6 variety of computer software applications that meet commission
- 7 specifications for a standard file format without the need to
- 8 reenter the information; and
- 9 (B) export information from the statement to a
- 10 variety of computer software applications that meet commission
- 11 specifications for a standard file format without the need to
- 12 reenter the information.
- 13 SECTION 2. The Texas Ethics Commission shall implement the
- 14 electronic filing system required by Section 572.0305, Government
- 15 Code, as added by this Act, not later than September 1, 2004.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
