3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Chapter 81, Labor Code, is amended by adding
5	Section 81.0046 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 81.0046. PROMOTION OF EMPLOYEE DEPENDENT CARE
7	BENEFITS. In providing technical assistance and information under
8	this chapter, the clearinghouse shall encourage employers to
9	provide employee dependent care benefits by:
10	(1) promoting the economic benefits realized by
11	employers who provide dependent care benefits, including decreased
12	absenteeism and turnover rates, greater productivity, and federal
13	and state tax incentives;
14	(2) advertising the availability of federal and state
15	tax incentives for employee dependent care benefits;
16	(3) providing technical assistance to employers who
17	establish employee dependent care benefit programs, including
18	assistance in obtaining federal and state tax incentives; and
19	(4) providing technical assistance and managerial
20	support to dependent care providers, including mentoring,
21	establishing cooperatives to pool resources for employee benefits,
22	and assisting with human resources and payroll functions.
23	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
24	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
