No. 1022 (c) A school district's decision under Subsection (b) is not 1 2 subject to appeal under this chapter, and the notice and hearing requirements of this chapter do not apply to the decision. 3 4 (d) This section does not affect the rights and remedies of 5 a party in an at-will employment relationship. (e) This section does not apply to a certified teacher 6 assigned to teach a subject for which the teacher is not certified. 7 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003, and 8 applies only to a contract entered into by a school district and an 9 educator on or after that date. 10
