2	relating to staff development requirements in public schools.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 21.451(a), Education Code, is amended to
5	read as follows:
6	$[\frac{a}{a}]$ The staff development provided by a school district
7	must be:
8	(1) conducted in accordance with [minimum] standards
9	developed by the district; and
10	(2) designed to improve education in the district
11	[commissioner for program planning, preparation, and improvement.
12	The staff development:
13	[(1) must include training in:
14	[(A) technology;
15	(B) conflict resolution; and
16	(C) discipline strategies, including classroom
17	management, district discipline policies, and the student code of
18	conduct adopted under Section 37.001 and Chapter 37;
19	[(2) must include training that:
20	[(A) relates to instruction of students with
21	disabilities; and
22	[(B) is designed for educators who work primarily
23	outside of the area of special education; and
24	[(3) may include instruction as to what is permissible

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- 1 under law, including opinions of the United States Supreme Court,
- 2 in regard to prayers in public school].
- 3 SECTION 2. Sections 21.451(b) and (c), Education Code, are
- 4 repealed.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2003-2004
- 6 school year.
- 7 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
