- 4 SECTION 1. Section 521.271(a), Transportation Code, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 (a) Each original driver's license and provisional license
- 7 expires as follows:
- 8 (1) a driver's license expires on the first birthday of
- 9 the license holder occurring after the sixth anniversary of the
- 10 date of the application;
- 11 (2) a provisional license expires on the earlier of:
- 12 (A) the 18th birthday of the license holder; or
- 13 (B) the first birthday of the license holder
- 14 occurring after the date of the application;
- 15 (3) an instruction permit expires on the second
- 16 [first] birthday of the license holder occurring after the date of
- 17 the application; and
- 18 (4) an occupational license expires on the first
- 19 anniversary of the court order granting the license.
- 20 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 21 to an instruction permit issued on or after the effective date of
- 22 this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
