1-8 AN ACT

1-9 relating to expiration of a driving instruction permit.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Section 521.271(a), Transportation Code, is
1-12 amended to read as follows:

1-13 (a) Each original driver's license and provisional license
1-14 expires as follows:

1-15 (1) a driver's license expires on the first birthday of
1-16 the license holder occurring after the sixth anniversary of the
1-17 date of the application;

1-18 (2) a provisional license expires on the earlier of:

1-19 (A) the 18th birthday of the license holder; or

1-20 (B) the first birthday of the license holder
1-21 occurring after the date of the application;

1-22 (3) an instruction permit expires on the second
1-23 [~~first~~] birthday of the license holder occurring after the date of
1-24 the application; and

1-25 (4) an occupational license expires on the first
1-26 anniversary of the court order granting the license.

1-27 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
1-28 to an instruction permit issued on or after the effective date of
1-29 this Act.

1-30 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
