(a) This Act takes effect September 1, 2003. 8 (b) The change in law made by this Act applies only to an offense committed on or after September 1, 2003. 9 An offense committed before September 1, 2003, 10 (c) is covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and the 11 former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of 12 this section, an offense was committed before September 1, 2003, if 13 any element of the offense was committed before that date. 14
