- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 63.032(b) and (c), Agriculture Code,
- 6 are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b) [If the home office or the principal place of business
- 8 of the person applying for registration is located outside this
- 9 state, the application must be accompanied by a written instrument
- 10 appointing a resident agent for service of legal process.
- 11 $\left[\frac{(c)}{c}\right]$ The service may prescribe and furnish forms for
- 12 registration of commercial fertilizers under this chapter. The
- 13 service shall provide a registrant with a copy of the approved
- 14 registration.
- 15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 19 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
