2 relating to an application for registration of a commercial  
3 fertilizer.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Sections 63.032(b) and (c), Agriculture Code,  
6 are amended to read as follows:

7 (b) ~~[If the home office or the principal place of business~~  
8 ~~of the person applying for registration is located outside this~~  
9 ~~state, the application must be accompanied by a written instrument~~  
10 ~~appointing a resident agent for service of legal process.~~

11 [(c)] The service may prescribe and furnish forms for  
12 registration of commercial fertilizers under this chapter. The  
13 service shall provide a registrant with a copy of the approved  
14 registration.

15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
19 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
