1-15	of the person applying for registration is located outside this
1-16	state, the application must be accompanied by a written instrument
1-17	appointing a resident agent for service of legal process.
1-18	[(c)] The service may prescribe and furnish forms for
1-19	registration of commercial fertilizers under this chapter. The
1-20	service shall provide a registrant with a copy of the approved
1-21	registration.
1-22	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
