1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to the continuance of the municipal court technology fund
1-9 and the purposes for which the fund may be used.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Article 102.0172(d), Code of Criminal Procedure,
1-12 is amended to read as follows:

1-13 (d) A fund designated by this article may be used only to
1-14 finance the purchase of or to maintain technological enhancements
1-15 for a municipal court or municipal court of record, including:

- 1-16 (1) computer systems;
- 1-17 (2) computer networks;
- 1-18 (3) computer hardware;
- 1-19 (4) computer software;
- 1-20 (5) imaging systems;
- 1-21 (6) electronic kiosks;
- 1-22 (7) electronic ticket writers; and
- 1-23 (8) docket management systems.

1-24 SECTION 2. Article 102.0172(f), Code of Criminal Procedure,
1-25 is repealed.

1-26 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
