| 4 | BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: |
| 5 | SECTION 1. Subchapter J, Chapter 49, Water Code, is amended |
| 6 | by adding Section 49.3075 to read as follows: |
| 7 | Sec. 49.3075. EXCLUSION FOR FAILURE TO PROVIDE SUFFICIENT |
| 8 | SERVICES. (a) The board shall call a hearing on the exclusion of |
| 9 | land from a district on a written petition filed with the secretary |
| 10 | of the board by a landowner whose land has been included in and |
| 11 | taxable by the district for more than 20 years if any bonds issued |
| 12 | by the district payable in whole or in part from taxes of the |
| 13 | district are no longer outstanding and the petition: |
| 14 | (1) includes a signed petition evidencing the consent |
| 15 | of the owners of a majority of the acreage proposed to be excluded, |
| 16 | as reflected by the most recent certified tax roll of the district; |
| 17 | (2) includes a claim that the district has not met the |
| 18 | landowner's proposals and requests for facilities and services |
| 19 | sufficient to service the land at full development; and |
| 20 | (3) describes the property to be excluded. |
| 21 | (b) The board shall hold the hearing at the earliest |
| 22 | practicable time after receipt of the petition. |
| 23 | (c) Unless the district presents evidence at the hearing |
| 24 | that conclusively demonstrates that the requirements and grounds |

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| 1 | for exclusion described by Subsection (a) have not been met, the |
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| 2 | board shall enter an order excluding the land from the district and |
| 3 | shall redefine in the order the boundaries of the district to |
| 4 | embrace all land not excluded. |
| 5 | (d) A copy of an order excluding land and redefining |
| 6 | boundaries of the district shall be filed in the deed records of the |
| 7 | county or counties in which the district is located. |
| 8 | SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives |
| 9 | a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as |
| 10 | provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this |
| 11 | Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this |
| 12 | Act takes effect September 1, 2003. |
