## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the regulation of air conditioning and refrigeration
- 3 contractors and technicians.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 1302.152, Occupations Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 1302.152. COMPLAINT INVESTIGATION. (a) The <u>department</u>
- 8 [commissioner] shall investigate a consumer complaint filed with
- 9 the department [commissioner].
- 10 (b) The executive director [commissioner] may take
- 11 appropriate action under Section 51.353 if the executive director
- 12 [commissioner] determines after an investigation that a license or
- 13 <u>certificate</u> holder violated this chapter or a rule adopted under
- 14 this chapter.
- 15 SECTION 2. Chapter 1302, Occupations Code, is amended by
- 16 adding Subchapter K to read as follows:
- 17 SUBCHAPTER K. AIR CONDITIONING AND REFRIGERATION TECHNICIANS
- Sec. 1302.501. DEFINITIONS. In this subchapter:
- 19 (1) "Air conditioning and refrigeration technician"
- 20 means a person who assists a licensed air conditioning and
- 21 refrigeration contractor in performing air conditioning and
- 22 refrigeration contracting.
- 23 (2) "Certificate" means a certificate of registration
- 24 issued under this subchapter.

- 1 Sec. 1302.502. REGISTRATION REQUIRED. (a) A person may not
- 2 act as an air conditioning and refrigeration technician unless the
- 3 person holds a certificate of registration issued under this
- 4 subchapter.
- 5 (b) A certificate is valid throughout the state. A person
- 6 who holds a certificate is not required to be registered in a
- 7 municipality to assist in air conditioning and refrigeration
- 8 contracting.
- 9 Sec. 1302.503. RULES. The department may adopt rules to
- 10 implement this subchapter.
- 11 Sec. 1302.504. SUPERVISION REQUIREMENTS FOR REGISTRANTS.
- 12 (a) An air conditioning and refrigeration technician must be
- 13 supervised by an air conditioning and refrigeration contractor
- 14 licensed under this chapter.
- 15 (b) A certificate holder shall notify the department in
- 16 writing not later than the 30th day after the date on which a change
- 17 occurs in the identity of an air conditioning and refrigeration
- 18 contractor who supervises the certificate holder.
- 19 Sec. 1302.505. APPLICATION; FEE. (a) An applicant for a
- 20 certificate must submit an application on a form prescribed by the
- 21 <u>executive director</u>.
- (b) The application must be completed and accompanied by:
- 23 <u>(1) the application fee; and</u>
- 24 (2) the name and license number of each air
- 25 conditioning and refrigeration contractor who will supervise the
- 26 applicant.
- 27 Sec. 1302.506. WAIVER OF REGISTRATION REQUIREMENT. The

- 1 executive director may waive any registration requirement for an
- 2 applicant who holds a registration issued by another state that has
- 3 a reciprocity agreement with this state.
- 4 Sec. 1302.507. ISSUANCE AND TERM OF REGISTRATION. (a) On
- 5 receipt of a completed application, the department shall issue a
- 6 certificate to an applicant who meets the requirements of this
- 5 subchapter.
- 8 (b) A certificate is valid for one year from the date of
- 9 issuance.
- 10 Sec. 1302.508. RENEWAL OF REGISTRATION. To renew a
- 11 certificate a certificate holder must:
- 12 <u>(1) submit a renewal request on a form prescribed by</u>
- 13 the executive director;
- 14 (2) provide the name and license number of each air
- 15 conditioning and refrigeration contractor who will supervise the
- 16 certificate holder; and
- 17 (3) pay the required renewal fee.
- SECTION 3. Section 411.093(a), Government Code, is amended
- 19 to read as follows:
- 20 (a) The Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation is
- 21 entitled to obtain from the department criminal history record
- 22 information maintained by the department that relates to a person
- 23 who is:
- 24 (1) an applicant for a license or registration under:
- 25 (A) Chapter 1302, Occupations Code; or
- 26 (B) Chapter 2052, Occupations Code [the Texas
- 27 Boxing and Wrestling Act (Article 8501-1, Vernon's Texas Civil

- 1 Statutes); or
- 2 (2) the holder of a license or registration under
- 3 <u>those chapters</u> [that Act].
- 4 SECTION 4. Effective March 31, 2004, Section 1302.062,
- 5 Occupations Code, is repealed.
- 6 SECTION 5. Not later than December 31, 2003, the Texas
- 7 Department of Licensing and Regulation shall adopt rules
- 8 implementing Subchapter K, Chapter 1302, Occupations Code, as added
- 9 by this Act.
- SECTION 6. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b) of this
- 11 section, this Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
- 12 (b) Sections 1302.502 and 1302.504, Occupations Code, as
- added by this Act, take effect March 31, 2004.
