- 9 SECTION 2. Section 152.074, Local Government Code, is
- amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsections (a-1) and
- 11 (c) to read as follows:
- 12 (a) In a county with a population of 150,000 or more, the
- 13 commissioners court shall provide to [longevity pay for] each
- 14 commissioned deputy of the sheriff's department longevity pay in an
- amount [of] not less than \$5 a month for each year of service in the
- department, up to and including 25 years. Each commissioned deputy
- is entitled to the longevity pay in addition to the deputy's regular
- 18 compensation.
- 19 (a-1) In a county with a population of 150,000 or more, the
- 20 commissioners court may provide to each county jailer of the
- 21 sheriff's department longevity pay in the amount provided to a
- 22 commissioned deputy under Subsection (a).
- 23 (c) In this section, "county jailer" has the meaning
- 24 assigned by Section 1701.001, Occupations Code.
