A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to longevity pay for county jailers employed by certain
3 sheriff's departments.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 152.074, Local Government
6 Code, is amended to read as follows:

7 Sec. 152.074. LONGEVITY PAY FOR COMMISSIONED DEPUTIES AND
8 COUNTY JAILERS.

9 SECTION 2. Section 152.074, Local Government Code, is
10 amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsections (a-1) and
11 (c) to read as follows:

12 (a) In a county with a population of 150,000 or more, the
13 commissioners court shall provide to [~~longevity pay for~~] each
14 commissioned deputy of the sheriff's department longevity pay in an
15 amount [~~of~~] not less than \$5 a month for each year of service in the
16 department, up to and including 25 years. Each commissioned deputy
17 is entitled to the longevity pay in addition to the deputy's regular
18 compensation.

19 (a-1) In a county with a population of 150,000 or more, the
20 commissioners court may provide to each county jailer of the
21 sheriff's department longevity pay in the amount provided to a
22 commissioned deputy under Subsection (a).

23 (c) In this section, "county jailer" has the meaning
24 assigned by Section 1701.001, Occupations Code.

1 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
