15	(b) The department may solicit and accept gifts, grants, and

18	meet the primary goal of increasing awareness in appropriate
19	populations of the availability of discount drug price programs
20	offered by pharmaceutical companies. To the extent that adequate
21	resources are available, the department shall:
22	(1) make information regarding discount drug price
23	programs readily available on the department's Internet site;
24	(2) maintain a toll-free telephone number through

- 3 (3) make brochures or other written informational

- 8 <u>(1) conduct community outreach and education</u>
- 9 activities to increase awareness of the availability of discount
- 10 drug price programs offered by pharmaceutical companies;
- 11 (2) solicit and train volunteers to perform functions
- 12 associated with the Texas Cares program, including:
- 13 (A) providing assistance to eligible persons in
- 14 enrolling in discount drug price programs offered by pharmaceutical

- 16 (B) conducting community outreach and education
- 17 activities; and
- 18 (3) coordinate operation of the Texas Cares program
- 19 with the activities of area agencies on aging.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
