- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 18, Civil Practice and
- 5 Remedies Code, is amended by adding Section 18.033 to read as
- 6 follows:
- 7 Sec. 18.033. STATE LAND RECORDS. (a) In a dispute
- 8 involving the littoral boundaries of state-owned land, the
- 9 documents, including maps and surveys, placed of record in the
- 10 archives of the General Land Office are presumed to accurately
- 11 depict the boundaries described in those documents.
- 12 (b) This presumption applies only to those surveys
- conducted by a licensed state land surveyor or county surveyor.
- 14 (c) This presumption may be overcome only on a showing of
- 15 clear and convincing evidence that the boundary as described and
- depicted in the archives of the General Land Office is erroneous.
- 17 SECTION 2. (a) This Act takes effect immediately if it
- 18 receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each
- 19 house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution.
- 20 If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate
- 21 effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
- 22 (b) The change in law made by Section 18.033, Civil Practice
- 23 and Remedies Code, as added by this Act, applies only to an action
- that is instituted on or after the effective date of this Act.
