5	SECTION 1. Sections 21.106(a) and (b), Education Code, are
6	amended to read as follows:
7	(a) In lieu of discharging a teacher employed under a
8	continuing contract, terminating a teacher employed under a term
9	contract, or not renewing a teacher's term contract, a school
10	district may[, with the written consent of the teacher,] return the
11	teacher to probationary contract status <u>under a written agreement</u>
12	between the teacher and the board of trustees of the district or the
13	board's designee if the teacher receives prior [-
14	[(b) A teacher may agree to be returned to probationary
15	contract status only after receiving] written notice of <u>:</u>
16	(1) the proposed discharge, termination, or
17	nonrenewal <u>; or</u>
18	(2) the superintendent's intent to recommend
19	discharge, termination, or nonrenewal.
20	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
