4	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 31, Education Code, is
5	amended by adding Section 31.0011 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 31.0011. FREE TEXTBOOKS FOR PRIVATE SCHOOL STUDENTS.
7	(a) In this section, "private school" has the meaning assigned by
8	<u>Section 39.033.</u>

- 9 (b) On request, the State Board of Education shall provide 10 free textbooks to:
- 11 (1) a private school student; or
- 12 (2) a private school applying on behalf of a student
 13 enrolled at the school.
- 14 <u>(c) A private school may apply for free textbooks under</u>
 15 <u>Subsection (b)(2) only under a written agreement between the</u>
 16 student and the school.
- 17 (d) The board may provide a free textbook under this section
 18 only if the textbook is adopted by the board as part of the textbook
 19 program described by this chapter.
- (e) Section 31.104 applies to a textbook issued under this section, except that a student who receives a textbook directly from the board shall return the textbook to the board.
- 23 <u>(f) The board shall adopt an application form that must be</u> 24 <u>used to receive free textbooks under this section.</u>

- SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2003-2004
- 2 school year.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
