## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to nonprofit water supply and sewer service corporations
- 3 in certain counties.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 67.011, Water Code, is amended to read as
- 6 follows:
- 7 Sec. 67.011. ADDITIONAL POWERS OF CORPORATION [IN CERTAIN
- 8 COUNTIES]. In addition to other powers granted by this chapter, [In
- 9 a county with a population of less than 3.3 million, a corporation
- 10 may:
- 11 (1) own, hold, lease, or otherwise acquire water
- wells, springs, or other sources of water supply;
- 13 (2) build, operate, and maintain pipelines to
- 14 transport water or wastewater;
- 15 (3) build and operate plants and equipment necessary
- 16 to distribute water or to treat and dispose of wastewater; and
- 17 (4) sell water or provide wastewater services to a
- 18 political subdivision, a private corporation, or an individual.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
