5	SECTION 1. Section 67.011, Water Code, is amended to read as
6	follows:
7	Sec. 67.011. <u>ADDITIONAL</u> POWERS OF CORPORATION [IN CERTAIN
8	COUNTIES]. In addition to other powers granted by this chapter, [In
9	a county with a population of less than 3.3 million,] a corporation
10	may:
11	(1) own, hold, lease, or otherwise acquire water
12	wells, springs, or other sources of water supply;
13	(2) build, operate, and maintain pipelines to
14	transport water or wastewater;
15	(3) build and operate plants and equipment necessary
16	to distribute water or to treat and dispose of wastewater; and
17	(4) sell water or provide wastewater services to a
18	political subdivision, a private corporation, or an individual.
19	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
20	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
21	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
22	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
23	Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
