## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2	relating to county civil service coverage for deputy constables.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 158, Local Government
5	Code, is amended by adding Section 158.0105 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 158.0105. DEPUTY CONSTABLES. (a) This section
7	applies only to a deputy constable whom the commission defines as a
8	county employee.
9	(b) At the conclusion of the term for which a constable is
10	elected or appointed, a deputy constable appointed by the constable
11	is no longer entitled to the coverage of the county civil service
12	system.
13	(c) A deputy constable who loses coverage under Subsection
14	(b) and is appointed as a deputy constable in the same or a
15	different constable precinct in the county resumes coverage under
16	the county civil service system without the probationary period
17	described by Section 158.010(b) if the appointment occurs not later
18	than the 30th day after the date the deputy loses coverage.
19	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
