5 SECTION 1. Section 36.1071, Water Code, is amended by

amending Subsection (h) and adding Subsection (i) to read as

- 8 (h) In developing its management plan, the district shall
- 9 use the groundwater availability modeling information provided by
- 10 the executive administrator in conjunction with any available
- 11 site-specific information provided by the district [and acceptable
- 12 to the executive administrator].
- 13 (i) If the district anticipates using site-specific
- 14 information, not later than the 60th day before the date of the
- 15 public hearing at which adoption of the management plan is first
- 16 considered, the district shall submit the site-specific
- information to the executive administrator for review and comment.
- 18 The executive administrator shall provide comments to the district
- 19 <u>in a timely manner so that the comments are available for</u>
- 20 consideration at the public hearing. The district shall consider
- 21 the comments received from the executive administrator and may
- 22 revise the management plan accordingly before it is adopted.
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
