2 relating to the use of site-specific information by a groundwater 3 conservation district to develop its management plan.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 36.1071, Water Code, is amended by 6 amending Subsection (h) and adding Subsection (i) to read as 7 follows:

8 (h) In developing its management plan, the district shall 9 use the groundwater availability modeling information provided by 10 the executive administrator in conjunction with any available 11 site-specific information provided by the district [and acceptable 12 to the executive administrator].

(i) If the district anticipates using site-specific 13 14 information, not later than the 60th day before the date of the public hearing at which adoption of the management plan is first 15 considered, the district shall submit the site-specific 16 information to the executive administrator for review and comment. 17 The executive administrator shall provide comments to the district 18 in a timely manner so that the comments are available for 19 consideration at the public hearing. The district shall consider 20 21 the comments received from the executive administrator and may revise the management plan accordingly before it is adopted. 22

23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
