A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the use of site-specific information by a groundwater
- 3 conservation district to develop its management plan.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 36.1071, Water Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsection (h) and adding Subsection (i) to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (h) In developing its management plan, the district shall
- 9 use the groundwater availability modeling information provided by
- 10 the executive administrator in conjunction with any available
- 11 site-specific information provided by the district [and acceptable
- 12 to the executive administrator].
- (i) If, on review of the management plan, the executive
- 14 administrator determines that any of the site-specific information
- 15 provided by the district under Subsection (h) is unreliable, the
- 16 <u>executive administrator shall notify</u> the district. The district
- 17 shall consider any comments received from the executive
- administrator and may amend the management plan accordingly.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
