(a) From money available for this purpose, the board may 9 award grants to match all or part of the contributions to a savings 10 11 trust account under this subchapter or all or part of the payments 12 under a prepaid tuition contract under Subchapter F for a beneficiary who resides in Texas and has a family income not greater 13 14 than the income level established by the board, which may not exceed the statewide median family income, adjusted for family size, 15 16 established by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development. 17 18 (b) For purposes of awarding grants under this section, the board shall establish and use a sliding scale under which the amount 19 of a grant is determined according to the family income of the 20 21 beneficiary and the amount of the contributions to the savings trust account or the payments made under the prepaid tuition 22 23 contract. 24 (c) The board may solicit and accept gifts and grants from

## 1 any public or private source for the purposes of this section.

2 (d) The legislature may appropriate money for the purposes
3 of this section.

4 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
