H.B. No. 1220

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the establishment of an offense for failing to return to
3 an employer items that may be used to impersonate a security
4 officer.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 1702.387, Occupations
7 Code, is amended to read as follows:

8 Sec. 1702.387. FAILURE TO SURRENDER CERTAIN ITEMS
9 [~~DOCUMENTS~~]; OFFENSE.

10 SECTION 2. Section 1702.387, Occupations Code, is amended
11 by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:

12 (c) A person commits an offense if the person fails to
13 surrender immediately on demand, or not later than the seventh day
14 after the date of terminating employment, any uniform, badge, or
15 other item of equipment issued to the person by an employer that
16 could be used to impersonate a commissioned or noncommissioned
17 security officer.

18 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
