- 2 relating to management of the Gulf Intracoastal Waterway.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 51.003, Transportation Code, is amended
- 5 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 51.003. PURPOSE. In recognition of the economic
- 7 benefit to the state of the Gulf Coast Intracoastal Waterway, this
- 8 [This] state shall act as the nonfederal sponsor of the main channel
- 9 of the Gulf Coast Intracoastal Waterway from the Sabine River to the
- 10 Brownsville Ship Channel in order to:
- 11 (1) support the marine commerce and economy of this
- 12 state by providing for the shallow draft navigation of the state's
- 13 coastal waters in an environmentally sound manner;
- 14 (2) prevent waste of publicly and privately owned
- 15 natural resources;
- 16 (3) prevent or minimize adverse impacts on the
- 17 environment; and
- 18 (4) maintain, preserve, and enhance wildlife and
- 19 fisheries.
- SECTION 2. Sections 51.005(a) and (b), Transportation Code,
- 21 are amended to read as follows:
- 22 (a) The commission may acquire by gift, purchase, or
- 23 condemnation property or an interest in property that the
- 24 commission considers necessary to enable it to meet its

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- 1 responsibilities under this chapter, including, except as provided
- 2 by Subsection(b)(3), easements and rights-of-way for dredge
- 3 material disposal sites or channel alteration.
- 4 (b) The commission may not:
- 5 (1) acquire oil, gas, sulphur, or other minerals that
- 6 may be recovered without using the surface of land acquired by the
- 7 commission for exploration, drilling, or mining purposes;
- 8 (2) condemn any submerged public land under the
- 9 jurisdiction of the School Land Board; or
- 10 (3) <u>condemn property for dredge material disposal</u>
- 11 [acquire property, before September 1, 2005, for use as a disposal
- 12 site for dredged material from the Laguna Madre if the property, on
- 13 October 1, 1997, was subject to a habitat conservation plan].
- SECTION 3. Chapter 51, Transportation Code, is amended by
- adding Sections 51.012, 51.013, and 51.014 to read as follows:
- Sec. 51.012. CONTRACTS WITH LANDOWNERS. The commission may
- 17 contract with a landowner for the use of land as a disposal site for
- 18 dredged material.
- 19 Sec. 51.013. OPEN BAY DISPOSAL. (a) In this section,
- 20 "geotube" means a fabric tube filled with sand used in open bay
- 21 <u>disposal to prevent the erosion of dredged material.</u>
- (b) Open bay disposal of dredged material may take place
- 23 only during the months of November, December, and January, unless
- 24 an emergency caused by severe weather or other natural event
- 25 necessitates disposal in a different month.
- 26 (c) In disposing of dredged material under this section, the
- 27 department shall provide for the even distribution of material

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- 1 <u>among seagrass beds.</u>
- 2 (d) This section does not apply to the use of geotubes.
- 3 Sec. 51.014. FEES. The commission by rule may set a fee per
- 4 ton on barges using the Gulf Intracoastal Waterway.
- 5 SECTION 4. Section 51.005(d), Transportation Code, is
- 6 repealed.
- 7 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
