- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 11.09, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 7 (d) The commission by rule may provide an expiration date
- 8 for a class of permits that is two or more years after the date on
- 9 which the permits would otherwise expire under this code if the fee
- 10 for the permits is increased proportionately.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 61.03, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is
- 12 amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (d) to
- 13 read as follows:
- 14 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b) or (d), a license
- 15 may not be issued for a term longer than one year. Any license
- 16 except a branch, importer's, importer's carrier's, or temporary
- 17 license expires one year after the date on which it is issued.
- 18 (d) The commission by rule may provide an expiration date
- 19 for a class of licenses that is two or more years after the date on
- 20 which the licenses would otherwise expire under this code if the fee
- 21 for the licenses is increased proportionately.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
