4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Article 15.17, Code of Criminal Procedure, is

amended by adding Subsection (h) to read as follows:

- 7 (h)(1) If a magistrate knows or suspects that a person
- 8 brought before the magistrate after an arrest is a foreign
- 9 <u>national</u>, the magistrate shall inform the person that after an
- 10 arrest a foreign national has a right to communicate with an
- official from the consulate of the person's country. If the person
- 12 chooses to exercise the right to communicate with the consular
- 13 official, the magistrate shall notify an official of the penal
- 14 institution in which the person is confined that the person wants a
- foreign consular official to be notified. The official of the penal
- institution shall allow the person to communicate with, correspond
- with, and be visited by a consular official of the person's country.
- 18 <u>(2) In providing a foreign national with rights</u>
- 19 <u>described by Subdivision (1), the magistrate and official of the</u>
- 20 penal institution shall comply with policies and procedures adopted
- 21 by the United States Department of State that apply to the
- 22 notification of foreign consular officials on the arrest of foreign
- 23 nationals.
- 24 SECTION 2. Section 1701.253, Occupations Code, is amended

- 1 by adding Subsection (i) to read as follows:
- 2 (i) As part of the minimum curriculum requirements, the
- 3 <u>commission shall establish a statewide comprehensive education and</u>
- 4 training program on the requirements for handling the arrest and
- 5 detention of a foreign national as provided by Article 15.17(h),
- 6 Code of Criminal Procedure.
- 7 SECTION 3. (a) The Commission on Law Enforcement Officer
- 8 Standards and Education shall establish the curriculum for a
- 9 comprehensive education and training program for peace officers as
- 10 required by Section 1701.253(i), Occupations Code, as added by this
- 11 Act, on or before January 1, 2004.
- 12 (b) For persons who are licensed peace officers on September
- 13 1, 2003, the first course required under Section 1701.253(i),
- 14 Occupations Code, as added by this Act, must be completed before
- 15 September 1, 2005.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
