- 21 insurance policy, certificate, evidence of coverage, plan
- 22 document, or health benefit plan that is delivered, issued for
- delivery, or renewed before January 1, 2004, is governed by the law
- 24 as it existed immediately before the effective date of this Act, and
- 25 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
