- 6 SECTION 1. Section 141.064, Election Code, is amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 141.064. METHOD OF ACQUIRING SIGNATURE. A person
- 9 circulating a petition must:
- 10 (1) [before permitting a person to sign, point out and
- 11 read to the person each statement pertaining to the signer that
- 12 appears on the petition;
- 13 $\left[\frac{(2)}{2}\right]$ witness each signature;
- 14 $\underline{(2)}$ [$\overline{(3)}$] ascertain that each date of signing is
- 15 correct; and
- 16 (3) $[\frac{(4)}{}]$ before the petition is filed, verify each
- 17 signer's registration status and ascertain that each registration
- 18 number entered on the petition is correct.
- 19 SECTION 2. Section 141.065(a), Election Code, is amended to
- 20 read as follows:
- 21 (a) Each part of a petition must include an affidavit of the
- 22 person who circulated it stating that the person:
- (1) [pointed out and read to each signer, before the
- 24 petition was signed, each statement pertaining to the signer that

1 appears on the petition; 2 [(2)] witnessed each signature; 3 (2) [(3)] verified each signer's registration status; 4 and 5 (3) [(4)] believes each signature to be genuine and 6 the corresponding information to be correct.
